#### **CLARE COMMUNITY RESPONSE TEAM**

Since the COVID –19 crisis emerged in mid-March CLDC has been working with the Clare Volunteer Centre, Clare PPN, Clare County Council, Family Resource Centres and representatives of local community and voluntary groups to support local community groups in their COVID response. This Clare Community Response Team has worked on setting up the Clare Community Helpline, and is providing practical guidance to local community groups on how to volunteer safely, as well as support with insurance cover, travel permits and Garda vetting for volunteers.

Operators will assist at risk members of the public in accessing non-emergency and non-medical supports and advice during the current public health emergency.
